Tabled Document 1: Proposed Amendments to Bylaws clauses

Clause 4.25

4.2.5 Clause 4.2.1 (i) and (ii) above do not apply to:

- a vessel over 500 gross tonnage, if the vessel cannot be safely navigated in compliance with clause 4.2.1(i) and (ii) respectively;
- ii. a vessel powered by sail in relation to any other vessel powered by sail, while the vessels are participating in a yacht race or training administered by:
 - a. a club affiliated to Yachting New Zealand; or
 - b. a non-profit organisation involved in sail training or racing; or
- iii. a craft training for, or participating in, competitive rowing or paddling; or
- iv. a tug, pilot vessel, Harbourmaster vessel, emergency response craft or police vessel, if the vessel's duties cannot be performed in compliance with clause 4.2.1(i) and (ii) respectively or
- v. A vessel operating in an area subject to a speed uplifting if the vessel is operating in accordance with the terms of the speed uplifting.
- vi. Any board sports, where all other speed rules are followed.

Clause 4.26 and 4.27

4.2.6 Clause 4.2.1 (iii) and (iv) will not apply to:

- a vessel operating in an access lane or reserved area for the purpose for which it was designated;
- ii. a vessel operating in an area subject to a speed uplifting if the vessel is operating in accordance with the terms of the speed uplifting; or
- a vessel over 500 gross tonnage, if the vessel cannot be safely navigated in compliance with this clause; or
- iv. a craft training for, or participating in, competitive rowing or paddling; or
- a tug, pilot vessel, Harbourmaster vessel, emergency response craft or police vessel, if the vessel's duties cannot be performed in compliance with 4.2.1(iii) and (iv) respectively.
- vi. Any board sports, where all other speed rules are followed.
