

- Will be monitored by the CCC


>> Guidance and clarity will emerge over the 6 years..






## Critical (and useful) actions..

- Updated national climate projections and datasets (2023)
- Scope a national information portal
- Develop a Māori climate action platform
- Improved hazard disclosure on LIMs
- Integrated work programme on climate and biodiversity



# RM reform+ actions





## Funding actions

- Consider adaptation criteria for the Climate Emergency Response Fund
- Publish a programme of work on how the nation meets the costs of climate change
- Complete a case study to consider co-funding in flood resilience



## Guidance

- Councils need to have regard to NAP when making or changing RM Plans from November 2022
- Interim updated guidance on SLR/Coastal Hazards using latest IPCC report and VLM
- Rolling programme of non-stat adaptation guidance for local government over the next six years
