KEY DIRECTION: timing for targeted release of draft plan changes for feedback

#### Why?

- Meets RMA requirements to consult with iwing organisations, TLAs and ministries
- Enables detailed discussion and feedback from key stakeholders
- Informs our assessment and your policy decisions in 2025



Options	Pros	Cons
Recommended: Targeted release in July 2024	<ul> <li>Meets RMA requirements to consult with iwi organisations, TLAs and ministries</li> <li>Enables detailed discussion and feedback from key stakeholders to inform assessment and decisions in 2025</li> <li>Allows sufficient time to properly review and respond to feedback</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>High degree of uncertainty about national policy amendments and likely consistency with these.</li> <li>Messaging would have to make this clear.</li> </ul>
Alternative: Targeted release later (Nov/Dec 2024 latest)  Discussions with stakeholders on specific topics prior	<ul> <li>Meets RMA requirements to consult with iwi organisations, TLAs and ministries</li> <li>Enables detailed discussion and feedback from key stakeholders to inform assessment</li> <li>Allows more time to consider national policy shifts although they are unlikely to be certain by Dec 2024.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Restricts time available to properly consider and respond to feedback prior to decisions and notification in September 2025.</li> </ul>

## Assessment of draft plan change policy topics

#### **Category 1:**

Minor improves RPS/RNRP useability.

#### **Category 2:**

Change provides consequence and environmental ad land and water use benefits.

#### **Category 3:**

Moderate to high consequences with strong justification.

#### Category 4:

Moderate to high consequences and potentially affected by national changes

- 1. Revisit category 4 topics before releasing draft.
- 2. Progress plan change for categories 1-3 and amended 4.
- 3. Focus questions for draft plan change feedback on Category 3 and 4 topics.
